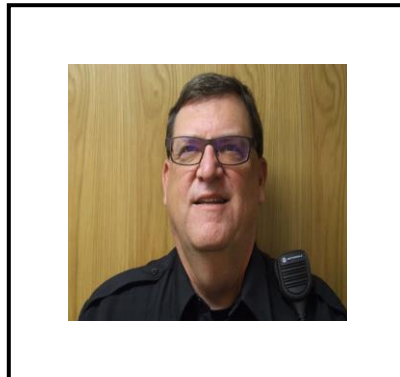
Tim Edwards replaces Dennis Engel as the Part-Time Sergeant

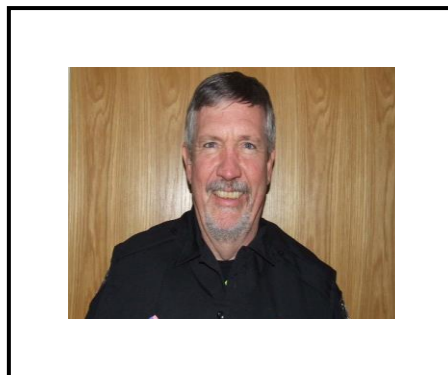
