Execute arrest warrants
Conduct frisk or pat down
Retain unruly or violent individuals and remove from court
Execute stop of motor vehicle and approach and talk to occupants
Make traffic arrest (physical custody)
Direct suspect vehicle out of traffic to execute high risk stop
Engage in high speed pursuit driving in congested area
Engage in high speed pursuit driving off road
Operate patrol vehicle on ice/snow covered road
Kick open a door with your foot
Tackle a fleeing suspect
Use weaponless defensive tactics
Use body pressure points to control person
Disarm violent suspects
Spike person with straight baton
Physically restrain crowd
Search for a person in a darkened building or environment
Fire weapon in self-defense at an attacking dangerous animal
Discharge firearm at a person
Detain person at gunpoint
Clean malfunction of various firearms
Discharge weapon in dark environment while using flashlight
Administer mouth-to-mouth resuscitation
Apply basic first aid to unresponsive/unconscious person
Apply basic first aid to treat for heart attach
Apply basic first aid to treat for stabbing or puncture wounds
Evacuate areas endangered by explosives, gases, liquids, etc.
Use protective gear to prevent contact with infectious disease
Respond to preliminary investigation of a homicide
Respond to preliminary investigation of a robbery
Respond to preliminary investigation of a felony theft
Respond to preliminary investigation of a misdemeanor assault
Respond to preliminary investigation of arson and bombings
Respond to preliminary investigation of custodial interference
Respond to preliminary investigation of crimes against
Respond to preliminary investigation of fatal traffic accident
Respond to preliminary investigation of vehicular homicide
Respond to preliminary investigation of personal injury crashes
Respond to preliminary investigation of felony traffic crimes
Respond to preliminary investigation of Death/bodies found
Intercede in domestic disputes to resolve, maintain peace, etc.
Use voice and words to calm a situation, send message, etc.
Use voice commands to project control and direct actions
Stop vehicle to investigate, warn or arrest
Ride and perform bike patrol

Arrest persons with a warrant
Handcuff suspects or prisoners
Conduct field interview of suspicious persons
direct violator vehicle out of moving traffic
Search for and collect physical evidence at accident scene
Watch occupant's vehicle to identify suspicious actions
Engage in high speed response driving in congested areas
Engage in high speed pursuit driving on open road
Engage in high speed response driving on open road
Push open a door with your shoulder
Break up fights between two or more persons
Subdue physically attacking person
Subdue person resisting arrest
Grip person tightly to prevent escape/control movement
Pull person out of a vehicle who is resisting arrest
Use hammer lock to hold person
Pull person through vehicle window/door to make arrest
Discharge firearm in low light conditions
Discharge firearm from protective positions
Draw weapon to protect self and third party
Reload firearm under combat conditions
Discharge shoulder weapon, e.g. rifle and shotgun
Administer cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
Apply basic first aid to control bleeding
Apply basic first aid to treat for gunshot wounds
Evacuate buildings in response to bomb threats
Talk with persons attempting suicide to get them to stop
Respond to and control scene involving barricaded subject
Use chemical agents and other riot equipment
Respond to preliminary investigation of a rape
Respond to preliminary investigation of a burglary
Respond to preliminary investigation of a kidnapping
respond to preliminary investigation of weapons offense
Respond to preliminary investigation of sex abuse
Respond to preliminary investigation of domestic violence
Respond to preliminary investigation of assaults
Respond to preliminary investigation of firearms accident
Respond to preliminary investigation of suicides
Respond to preliminary investigation of mental cases
Present testimony in legal and administrative proceedings
Speak to hostile groups to quiet them
Control hostile groups, e.g., demonstrators, rioters, etc.
Maintain calm to prevent making situation worse
Investigate suspicious vehicle
